Proposals Invited

Examples of potential areas of interest to conference participants include (note these are for illustrative purposes only and should not be considered limiting):

- ▲ Reports on implementation or maintenance of safety systems in organizations or industry
- ▲ Latest developments on research and theoretical aspects of safety
- ▲ New safety products or applications
- ▲ Performance, organizational or behavioral management
- ▲ Policy or regulatory regime
- ▲ Economics of safety

Proposal Guidelines

Please submit a 500 word abstract, summarizing the presentation and the presenter(s) professional background, emphasizing previous work in the area. We will also consider completed papers.

The deadline for submissions is July 30, 2012. Deadline for early decisions is June 1, 2012. Proposals will be reviewed by a faculty committee at IIT Gandhinagar and acceptances notified on a rolling basis after June 1, 2012.
